1. Israel - Hamas Statement

On motion of Trustee Cohen, seconded by Trustee Malatino, the following resolution was unanimously adopted:

WHEREAS, on October 7, 2023, Hamas terrorists launched a coordinated attack on Israel from the Gaza Strip; and

WHEREAS, Hamas has breached Israel's borders and kidnapped and held hostage civilians from numerous nations; and

WHEREAS, twenty-five Americans have been declared dead at the hands of Hamas; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Port Washington North that the Village of Port Washington North unequivocally condemns Hamas for this deplorable attack on Israel; and be it further

RESOLVED that the Village of Port North stands in solidarity with the State of Israel against this attack by Hamas, and supports Israel's right to defend itself and protect its citizens from indiscriminate violence and terrorism; and be it further

RESOLVED that the Village of Port Washington North commends and supports the United States government in its campaign demanding that Hamas immediately release all hostages and return them to safety; and be it further

RESOLVED that the Village of Port Washington North supports the right of the State of Israel to exist as a sovereign nation, with full recognition of its border and territory.
